

MAG 24 06 Tents and Camping Equipment: Questions & Clarifications

1. Do you have any idea of quantities?
 - This can be hard to calculate as many MAG programs buy tents in country and we hope this tender will provide them a better option. However the international procurement team has helped supply 212 tents to South Sudan, Angola and Zimbabwe in the past year.
2. Incoterms – Please clarify the delivery location and incoterms for the submission of our offer. Are the Incoterms Ex-Works or FCA factory acceptable for your purposes?
 - Whilst DAP is preferable, MAG can work with Ex-works or FCA Incoterms.
3. Packaging – Please advise if you require the goods to be palletized or will you accept the tents/camping accessories in unpalletized format.
 - MAG would prefer suppliers were able offer palletization. Smaller orders will work without pallets, but shipping larger orders of 30+ large tents will require pallets, MAG's freight forwarders can provide palletization services, but this will cause delay during order pick up.
4. Wall & Centre Height: What are the required wall and centre heights for the tent?
 - The specifications provided are for the height of centre for the tent, suppliers are to suggest side heights.
5. Tent Type: Do you want a Pole Tent (with central and side poles, high peak) or a Frame Tent (with a rigid frame and no central poles)?
 - MAG has no preference, suppliers can quote for either or both.
6. Tent 1 and Tent 2 – we have noted the requirement for the frame to be made of weather resistant spring steel. However, our tents are regularly manufactured with aluminum tube frame for flexibility purposes. Kindly advise if the aluminum tube frame will be acceptable.
 - Could be considered off course but would be needed to be supported by certified Technical data sheets for the specific materials being used.
7. Tents material – please confirm that cotton canvas material will be acceptable for the tents. Alternatively, kindly advise on the material and the GSM of the material that you require for the tents.
 - Other materials may be considered on the provision that they are supported by certified technical data sheets – as per question 7 above.
8. Dining tents – we have noted the requirement is for minimum of 220cm head clearance in the tent. However, kindly clarify if this means that the eaves of the tent should be 220cm height minimum or is the 220cm minimum height applicable to the roof of the tent.
 - Minimum height of the roof? 220 cm should be maximum height of the eaves.
